Sleep Away camp is for youth ages 8-12 and is held from August 19-22 at Lake Chautauqua Lutheran Camp. For the cost of \$110 Sleep Away campers enjoy delicious daily meals, swimming in the lake, arts, crafts, games, singing, and worship.

Junior High camp is for youth entering grades 7-9 and is held at the Dunkirk Conference Center on the shore of Lake Erie. The camp takes place from August 2nd-8th. Campers enjoy a week of swimming in the pool, arts and crafts, hot meals, and evening activities such as a dance and talent show! Price TBD.

Senior High camp is for youth entering grades 10-12 and 2009 graduates. Held on the campus

of SUNY Fredonia from June 28th- July 4th it offers a "taste of college life". Campers live in the dormitories and eat in the dining halls. Classes offer campers a chance to explore their personal faith and life issues and evening activities, such as a dance, movie night, and talent show, offer lots of time to have fun with their peers. Cost is \$320.
